Job Description: Home School Teacher

Job Summary: Implement high quality educational lesson plans for the girls of the Hosea's Heart home. Create an environment safe for learning where the girls can be empowered through education.

Responsibilities:

- Use the provided curriculum to structure lesson plans and enrichment activities for the homeschooled girls
- Support the education of the girls through individual tutoring
- Communicate with the Hosea's Heart board regarding progress, problems, and personal prayer requests
- Communicate with the director openly when problems arise and seek to resolve them in a timely manner
- Maintain positive relationships with Swazi volunteers and staff
- Organize receipts, transactions and other financial documents related to school expenses
- Update paperwork for each girl to document progress in their education
- Display a growing and personal relationship with Christ and encourage the girls to seek Christ in their own lives

Education and Work Experiences: Bachelor's degree preferred, or associate's degree with experience in teaching or working with at-risk girls. International travel experience is preferred.

- Current and growing relationship and dependency on Christ
 - Able to demonstrate and lead others in a Christian lifestyle
- Must be able to work with all personality types; flexible and patient
- Comfortable with ever-changing work environments and able to adapt
- Culturally sensitive
- Proficient or above in high school level math, science, english, and history
- Teachable and a willingness to learn with a humble attitude
- Strong interpersonal skills
- Able to thrive in Swaziland with a positive attitude

Work Environment: Hosea's Heart strives to partner with Swazis, which requires teachers to adapt to a unique work environment. Co-workers will be both Swazi and American. The nature of working with girls with past sexual abuse necessitates a steady and consistent personality that reflects Christ's love. Being a minority in a foreign country calls for a person who does not offend easily and is able to maintain a strong support system in their home country, and also calls for an ability reach out to build relationships with other people in Swaziland. The Swaziland school year spans January through December. Teachers must be well-rounded and able to teach multiple subjects.
